



MUNICIPAL TOURIST TAX

What is the goal of the Municipal Tourist Tax (MTT)?

The tax is designed to support the sustainability of Funchal as a tourist destination. Its funds are allocated to preserve, enhance, and maintain the city's infrastructure, services, and facilities.

How much is the MTT?

The tax is 2€ per night, up to a maximum of 7 consecutive nights, per person, per stay. The maximum amount to be paid by the guest is 14€ (for a maximum of 7 consecutive nights).

Who has to pay the Municipal Tourist Tax?

Everyone staying in Funchal who is over 12 and does not live in Madeira has to pay the tax.

Who is exempt from paying the Municipal Tourist Tax?

- Guests with a disability of 60% or more
- Children aged 12 or under
- Residents of the Autonomous Region of Madeira

When and how is it paid?

The tax comes into effect on the 1st of October 2024 and must be charged before or during the guest's stay.
